

# PROHIBITED ITEMS

## Be Aware of the Following:

- **Haitian Customs** forbids the exportation of certain Haitian artifacts (i.e., cannonballs)
- **U.S. Customs** may confiscate certain fruits, beads, Cuban cigars, vegetables, plants, animal meats or hides; e.g., Haitian drums
- Equipment with small engines must have all fuel drained before shipment (generators, motorcycles, etc.)

## Do Not Pack:

- Alcohol
- Tobacco Products
- Explosives (Fireworks, Gunpowder, Firearms)
- Military gear (e.g. body armor, handcuffs, night sticks, etc.)
- Toy guns and weapons
- \$10,000 or more of cash per passenger
- Oil-based paints
- Batteries that are considered hazardous (flooded lead-acid car batteries, lithium batteries greater than 160 Wh)
- Expired items (e.g. food and medication)
- All aerosols; e.g., hairspray, deodorant, bug spray, etc.
